Children and well behaved dogs are welcome but must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Some of the walks will cross farmland when we ask that all dogs are on a lead.

**Accessibility** : Mostly defined paths, but some paths cross fields and will depend on the ground conditions

**Reflection** : Treading the path that pilgrims have trodden and passing a place of worship - Cistercian Way.
